This summer we will be sending home a Summer Bridge Activities Workbook with each student who will be entering grades KG - 5. Students must return the completed Summer Bridge Activities Workbooks at the beginning of the school year for **credit towards their 1st quarter grade**. Please help your child complete the Summer Bridge Activities workbook by slowly working through it during summer break.

Summer Bridge Activities Workbook

The workbook is the core of your child's summer learning program. It has two pages of fun activities for each weekday of the summer and supports your child's skills in language arts, reading, math, science, social studies, fitness, and character development. Skills your child learned last year are reviewed toward the beginning of the book. Skills for the year to come are introduced toward the end. Encourage your child to use the workbook's bonus features. Cut out the flashcards from the back of the book and thread them onto a ring or keep in a zip-top bag so you can take them on the go. Let your child use a star sticker to show that each day's activities are complete.
